CLOSING TIME: Library, YMCA to Close All Day Thursday, Expect More

The expected heavy snowfall on Thursday has caused Darien Library and Darien YMCA to announce they'll be closed all day. Any other organizations that decide to close will be announced in updates to this article.

Tonight

A slight chance of rain and snow between 2am and 4am, then snow likely. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 32. Wind chill values between 25 and 30. North wind 10 to 13 mph. Chance of precipitation is 70%. Total nighttime snow accumulation of less than one inch possible.

Thursday

Snow, mainly before 4pm. The snow could be heavy at times. Temperature falling to around 28 by noon. Wind chill values between 15 and 25. Windy, with a north wind 16 to 21 mph increasing to 23 to 28 mph in the morning. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New snow accumulation of 7 to 11 inches possible.

Thursday Night

A 30 percent chance of snow before 7pm. Mostly cloudy, then gradually becoming mostly clear, with a low around 17. Wind chill values between 5 and 10. Blustery, with a northwest wind 20 to 25 mph decreasing to 13 to 18 mph after midnight.

Friday

Mostly sunny, with a high near 29. Wind chill values between zero and 10. West wind 13 to 16 mph.

Friday Night

A 40 percent chance of light snow. Cloudy, with a low around 26. West wind 6 to 8 mph becoming south after midnight.

Saturday

Cloudy, with a high near 39.

Saturday Night

A 30 percent chance of rain after 1am. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 35.

Sunday

A 50 percent chance of rain. Cloudy, with a high near 44.

Sunday Night

A 40 percent chance of rain. Cloudy, with a low around 37.
