You can get your flu shot and learn about various ways to stay healthy at the Darien Health Fair from 2:30 to 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, Oct. 21 at Mather Community Center.

Darien Health Department nurses will be administering flu vaccine for those 3 years of age and older.

All vaccine, regular and high dose (for people 65 and older) is preservative-free. For this event only, the cost for vaccine is \$15, cash or check ONLY. There will be no credit card or Medicare payments accepted.

Special arrangements have been made to provide vaccine for Board of Education employees.

Here's what else you can do, according to a news release from the Health Department:

- ? have your blood pressure, body mass index and oxygen levels checked,
- ? learn about hands only CPR, fall prevention
- ? get your posture assessed; learn about physical therapy
- ? get tips on bicycle, car seat and fire safety,
- ? learn about carbon monoxide dangers and preparing for disasters or emergencies,
- ? learn about healthy foods, diabetes, food allergies and nutritional counseling,
