

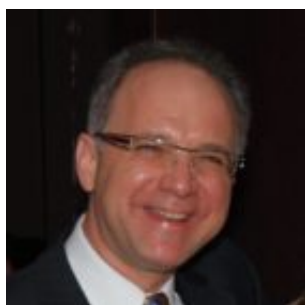
High School Teacher Speaks Wednesday on How His Students Win at Science, Engineering Fairs

The design of a low-cost portable test for ebola won the Grand Prize for one student, who received a scholarship of \$50,000.

Last year, six students were named Regeneron Science Talent Scholars. Two won a \$100,000 scholarship.
