Paul Damon Littlefield, 96, of Annisquam, Mass., died Feb. 10, 2017. He was the beloved husband of Lucy "Jackie" (Boyd) Littlefield and the late Emmy (Neiley) Littlefield.

Little, Inc in Cambridge, where he became chief financial officer and senior vice president. He retired in 1985 but continued to consult on financial matters.
