Presently, Fucigna is a full time professor of art at Norwalk Community College and is the chair of the Studio Arts Program. He resides and works in Weston.

RAC celebrates the study, creation and appreciation of the arts through classes, exhibitions and events open to all in the community. For almost 60 years, this nonprofit organization has been a cultural gem in Rowayton.
