[Science Sunday: Crystallized Colors](#): 1 to 3 p.m.: A drop-in program designed for children aged 4 and up and their families. Participants will explore simple science concepts and subjects while partaking in fun, kid-friendly experiments, projects and crafts inspired by the Museum's collections and exhibitions. This program is free with general admission and no advance registration is required. Join us for as we experiment with salt and watercolor to create beautiful, crystalized paintings.
