He is currently a vice president in the SPDR ETF division at State Street Global Advisors, the world’s third-largest asset manager.

Prior to joining State Street, Mr. Bosek served as an associate director on the exchange traded funds strategy and due diligence team at UBS Wealth Management. Prior to that, he worked at BMO Capital Markets, where he worked in institutional equity sales trading.
