Expect Weeks of Continued Lane Closures on Merritt in Greenwich, Stamford for Tree Cutting

A Merritt Parkway tree-removal project in Stamford and Greenwich, previously expected to end on Wednesday, Feb. 13, will instead continue through Friday, March 8, the state Department of Transportation [announced](#).

The work area stretches from Exit 29 (Old Mill Road in Greenwich) to Exit 33 (Den Road) and takes place from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on the northbound-traffic side of the parkway and from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on the southbound-traffic side, according to the announcement, which was released Thursday.

This Saturday, Feb. 16, only, work will be done from 6 a.m. to 1:30 pm.

Workers are clearing around signs, as well as cutting dead trees and high limbs.
