### *If You're Going ...*

- **\$20 entrance fee to attend the Alive@Five Festival.**
- **You must be 21 or older for admission. Infants and strollers prohibited.**
- **Photo ID is required for admission (valid and current motor vehicle operator’s license, identity card issued by the state Department of Motor Vehicles, or a passport along with another form of photo ID with date of birth).**
- **No Re-entry. Once you leave the music venue, you may not re-enter on same ticket.**
- **No entry through restaurant/bar/office back doors. Everyone must enter through single main entrance located on Main Street at Atlantic Street with multiple entry portals.**
- **As is City of Stamford policy, police reserve the right to limit entry due to crowd control, regardless of whether or not a patron has a ticket.**

- No backpacks or oversized bags larger than 18"x14"

- No coolers
- No chairs
- No bicycles or skateboards
