Influenced by the muses of Degas, Hirschfeld, and Haring, Appleby's ballet-inspired work has been exhibited in numerous galleries and was awarded 1st Prize in Drawing.

Appleby is an artist member of MoMA, the Whitney Museum, the Graphic Arts Guild, the Rowayton Arts Center, and the Stamford Art Association, and a member of the Art Students League.
