Metro-North Increases Train Service by 26%

Effective Wednesday, May 27, Metro-North is increasing service on the Hudson, Harlem and New Haven Lines as the Mid-Hudson region is expected to begin Phase 1 of reopening.
— an announcement from Metro-North (with non-New-Haven-Line information removed)
The expanded service represents an overall increase of 26% in peak train availability since our essential service went into effect on April 13. Metro-North will also have 14 protect trains strategically positioned at major facilities to operate additional service as may be necessary.

- New train departs New Haven at 6:19 a.m., all stops to Stamford at 7:26 a.m., express to Harlem/125th Street, arrives GCT at 8:19 a.m.
- Two new trains depart Stamford at 6:28 a.m. and 7:28 a.m., all stops to GCT arriving at 7:44 a.m. and 8:44 a.m.

Outbound:

- New train departs GCT at 4:34 p.m., Harlem-125th St, express to Stamford at 5:27 p.m., all stops to New Haven, arriving at 6:38 p.m.
- Two new trains depart GCT at 4:05 p.m. and 5:05 p.m., all stops to Stamford arriving at 5:21 p.m. and 6:21 p.m.

The following additional schedule and service changes will continue to be in effect:

- On the Danbury Branch, substitute busing which went into effect on May 16 until further notice;
- On the Waterbury Branch, substitute busing which went into effect on April 6 until further notice;

Off peak fares are in effect during this special schedule.
