

## National Weather Service Issues Severe Thunderstorm Watch From Noon to 8 PM Monday

The National Weather Service says showers and a thunderstorms are likely in the area, especially after 5 p.m., and the service has issued a Severe Thunderstorm Watch in effect until 8 p.m., Monday.

As of the 2:56 p.m. update, the weather service's [Darien-specific forecast](#) for Monday and Tuesday says:

### **This Afternoon**

Showers and thunderstorms likely, mainly after 5pm. Some of the storms could be severe. Partly sunny, with a high near 91. Heat index values as high as 95. Southwest wind around 11 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New rainfall amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch, except higher amounts possible in

thunderstorms.

### **Tonight**

Showers and thunderstorms likely, mainly before 1am. Some storms could be severe, with heavy rain. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 71. Southwest wind 6 to 8 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New rainfall amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms.

### **Tuesday**

Sunny, with a high near 85. Northwest wind around 8 mph.

### **Tuesday Night**

Mostly clear, with a low around 64. North wind around 8 mph.
