Powers will continue to serve as vicar general, officially the chief administrative deputy to the bishop for administration of a diocese. The Diocese of Bridgeport covers Fairfield County.

"I'm very grateful for the appointment, and also very grateful to Father Fank Hoffmann, the pastor now, for his friendship and his help and guidance over the past few days and weeks," Powers said in a video message to the parish. (You can watch the video below.)

In addition to being vicar general, Powers has been chaplain at Trinity Catholic High School in Stamford. He worked for a decade in Rome, at the Office of Bishops, Hoffman said.
