The 70's dance party and fundraising event, Saturday Night Fever, takes place in the DAC Weatherstone Studio, which will be transformed into a 1970's disco, complete with disco ball and a DJ playing all of the biggest hits of the era.

Guests can show off their best dance moves while enjoying drinks and hors d'oeuvres, and a prize for best costume will be awarded at this fun celebration open to all.

It is recommended to purchase tickets soon, as space is limited and the event is expected to sell out.
