Wallman has been the SRO at Darien High School since the 2016-2017 school year.

Schwengerer was <u>appointed this summer</u> as the first school resource officer at Middlesex Middle School. An 18-year veteran of the police force, he was previously one of two school liaison officers at the school.

Every school in Darien, along with some nursery school programs, has a Police Department liaison officer (SLO) who visits the school regularly. By contrast, each of the town's two school resource officers (SROs) are typically in his school all day.

School district officials agreed to creation of the SRO position in Middlesex Middle School after extensive discussions with Police Department officials, who proposed it.
