Running Supply and Events Store 'Darien Running Company' to Open Downtown in July

A store offering running supplies and events, Darien Running Company, will open this July at 14 Brook St., next door to the Sugar Bowl, in downtown Darien, its owner announced Thursday morning.

Megan Searfoss, who cofounded an associated store, the Ridgefield Running Company, in 2014, announced the new location in the RRC's newsletter. The RRC had plans to expand before the COVID-19 epidemic, which forced a lot of changes on the business.

Despite the pandemic, Searfoss said, she decided to go forward with plans for the new store, which she abbreviates as "DRC."

"DRC will offer the same services as Ridgefield Running Company, now retooled to provide a safe and

trusted environment," Searfoss said. "Our training programs, clinics and group runs will happen as soon as it is safe."

Runner's Roost, a store that sold supplies to runners for 40 years, closed its doors earlier this year. Darien Sport Shop also sells running shoes in downtown Darien.

"We are so excited about this new tenant!" David Genovese, principal of Baywater Properties, said in an email that forwarded Searfoss's announcement.

In the RRC newsletter, Searfoss also announced: "Ridgefield Running Company for the third consecutive year is recognized as 'Best Running Store in America for 2020,' an honor that puts us in the top 2% of run specialty stores! This award recognizes the RRC team, our programs, and our community engagement."
