A woman who parked her unlocked scooter at the Noroton Heights Railroad Station on Saturday, July 11, found it stolen two hours later, police said.

The motorized bike, a red and white ZHNG-BMS 50 cc scooter, is valued at \$2,000.

According to Darien police:

The woman, a 39-year-old Stamford resident, parked her vehicle on the south side of the station at 4:30 p.m. then returned to it two hours later. The police report didn't explain why she parked there for that period of time.

When she did return, she found the scooter missing.
