Solar Panels Delivered to Roof of Thorndal Circle Office Building

The installation by Stamford-based Peregrine Renewable Energy at 28 Thorndal will be the second by building owner Jerry Nielsen, who also recently installed solar panels atop 6 Thordal Circle, also with Peregrine.

The two buildings are part of Thorndal Circle Office Park. Both have deployed solar with 100-percent financing from Greenworks Lending via the state's C-PACE program, which allows for renewable and energy efficient building upgrades to be financed privately through a special tax assessment on commercial properties.

Literally just beneath the ongoing installation is an interesting commercial tenant —Greenworks Lending itself.

The Darien-based company is headquartered on the third floor of 28 Thorndal, and while operating nationally, has financed several renewable energy projects in Darien including 6 Thorndal, Mini of Fairfield County and 110 Boston Post Road, which is home to Post Modern Home and several additional businesses.
