- The 6:49 PM to New Haven will not operate.
- The 7:09 PM to Harrison will not operate.

On Wednesday, July 4, we will operate a Sunday schedule with one additional train on the New Haven Line to get you home from the annual <u>Macy's Fireworks</u>.

The train departs Grand Central Terminal at 11:14 p.m., making stops at Westport, Fairfield, Fairfield-Metro, Bridgeport, Stratford, Milford, West Haven, and New Haven.

Train service is also provided to Rye on the New Haven Line, with shuttle buses to Rye Playland where Westchester County puts on its own spectacular fireworks extravaganza over the Long Island Sound.
