U.S. Rep. Jim Himes, who represents Darien and the rest of the Fourth District in the U.S. House of

Representatives, is holding a Town Hall meeting to discuss current affairs with the public this coming Tuesday, Jan. 22 at Darien Town Hall.

The meeting starts at 6:30 p.m. at Town Hall, 2 Renshaw Road.

"If you're interested in attending, please click [HERE](#)," Himes said in an announcement to constituents. "Seating is limited and will be on a first-come first-served basis. Your RSVP does not guarantee a seat, but your response is appreciated for planning purposes."

"Over the last few weeks, I've heard from thousands of constituents who are concerned about the direction of our country," Himes, a Democrat, said in the announcement. "The divided 116th Congress presents many new exciting opportunities, but also challenges that require thoughtful debate."
