The administration and the President have been sued repeatedly over a wide range of issues — the Emoluments Clause; the Presidential Records Act; the administration’s orders related to immigrants and transgender military personnel; 2020 census questions — to name just a few. The list is overwhelming, and Blumenthal, a Democrat and resident of Greenwich, will help us make sense of it all.

The senator’s experience as Connecticut’s Attorney General for 20 years makes him uniquely qualified to explain the scope and intentions of the lawsuits, and he himself is a plaintiff in the emoluments lawsuit.
