While Saverine is proud of the invitation to hang his artwork at UCBC, he is happy to continue his history of supporting local nonprofits by donating 10% of his sales to Darien Land Trust.

“It’s great to support a worthwhile mission preserving open space in Darien for future generations-forever,” Saverine said. “Always appreciating the privilege of growing up in Darien, it is important to use my hobby to help make a small impact on the community. I believe artwork should be affordable so I will be showing a range of original work, large and small, from \$20 to \$450.”

The Darien Land Trust permanently preserves and restores open space, providing the community with environmentally rich habitats, scenic vistas, opportunities for educational experiences and the quiet enjoyment of nature.

The land trust now owns or has conservation easements over more than 200 acres in Darien. We have permanently protected diverse natural environments such as wetlands along the Five Mile River, tidal salt marshes at Holly Pond and Scott’s Cove, upland forests in Dunlap Woods, and meadow habitat at Mather Meadows, Fox Run, and Brendan’s Meadow. Peter was born and raised in Darien and currently resides in Fairfield with his wife, Holly. They are proud of their eight grandchildren aged seven years to two months-- all of whom live locally.

A graduate of Amherst College with a B.A. in political science, he is the director of philanthropy at STAR, Inc., a non-profit organization serving our neighbors of all ages who have intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Peter is a self-taught artist whose bright seascapes capture familiar scenes along Long Island Sound and favorite spots in Nantucket and Cape Cod.

Peter also authored and self-published three children’s books, his most notable about a mermaid at the Brant Point Lighthouse in Nantucket, titled "Jenny’s Pennies—A Nantucket Tradition," that has sold over 10,000 copies and is in its fifth printing.
