'Vote and Vax' — Town's Last Flu Clinic Is Today, Tuesday Until 7 PM in Town Hall

Darien Health Department issued an announcement Tuesday reminding the public that its last flu clinic is today in Town hall, from 3 to 7 p.m. in Room 119.

The announcement also said:

"The vaccine is available at no cost for all part-time/full-time Town employees, library, Post 53 and volunteer firefighters.

"For the public, the cost of flu vaccine is \$30, payable by check or cash or we accept ConnectiCare and Medicare Part B ONLY. Vaccine is preservative free & available to those over 3 years old.

"If you are unable to attend the flu clinic, you can make an appointment with our Public Health Nurse by
