What Mental Health First Aid Training Is

This Mental Health First Aid course is an interactive experience that will give you key skills to help anyone

developing a mental health problem, or experiencing a mental health crisis.

The eight-hour certification course is intended to help individuals and communities better understand mental health issues and respond accordingly to others who may be experiencing distress.

Mental Health First Aid is an interactive course designed to give members of the public key skills to help someone who is developing a mental health problem or experiencing a mental health crisis.

Similar to CPR training that helps a non-medical professional assist an individual following a heart attack, mental health first Aid training helps an individual who doesn't have clinical training assist someone experiencing a mental health crisis.

About the Program

"Mental health first aiders" learn:

- The prevalence of mental illnesses in the U.S.
- The potential warning signs of the most common mental health disorders.
- A five-step action plan to assist an individual in crisis.
- Resources available to help someone with a mental health problem.

The Instructor

Dawn Roy, a licensed clinical social worker, is in private practice in Fairfield, serving the mental health needs of the community.

She has been a mental health first aid instructor since 2009 providing over 100 training courses throughout Fairfield County and elsewhere in the state.

"I've taken the course myself twice and found it to be both informative and helpful," state Rep. Terrie Wood said in a recent email. "The instructor, Dawn Roy, is widely well-regarded and an excellent teacher."
